Management of the corona crisis

The German government has extended the declaration of an epidemic crisis on a national scale to June 30th. This means that all decisions on this remain with the Federal Government and the Prime Ministers in the Federal States. Due to increasing rates of infection, the lockdown has been extended to April 18th and contact restrictions have again been tightened. With the withdrawal of the decision to make Maundy Thursday and Easter Saturday public holidays, Chancellor Merkel and some State Prime Ministers admitted that this was a mistake. But trust in the management of the crisis is being challenged. The closing of businesses over the last five months, constant on and off relaxation of restrictions, changing test and trace strategies and sluggish progress with vaccinations offer little prospect and hope for a return to normality. The ban on attending Easter services in person has offended Christians. The economy is facing a wave of bankruptcies.

Scientists are also calling for criteria other than just infection rate statistics to be taken into consideration when imposing restrictive measures. After a year of the pandemic, data is now available worldwide on the good and the harm done by the lockdown measures. Other strategies will be necessary to deal with the virus, but they alone will evidently not defeat it. The aim must be to minimize the death rate and the economic and social damage in equal measure. How to deal with the virus crisis in more balanced and future-oriented way will also be the litmus test for the governing parties in how successful they will be in the federal elections coming up in the autumn, and especially for the CDU party.

Federal election 2021 - shaping the future

This is a decisive year for determining the way ahead. Like a magnifying glass, the corona crisis is bringing to our attention a long-awaited change that calls for a reform of our lives and our values. Pornography from the Internet:

Protection for children and young people

Studies from 2017 to 2019 tell us that more than half of 11 to 13-year-olds have already come into some contact with pornography through the Internet. 71% of 14 to 17-year-old boys watch pornographic material several times a week, and 21% even watch it on a daily basis. Lockdowns and online teaching have accelerated the use of digital devices (computers, tablets, laptops and smart-phones) in children's rooms immensely. As a result, many children came into contact with the wide world of the Internet for the first time - often without the necessary training (technical and educational) and instruction to protect them from easily accessible pornographic content. Cyber criminologists also report cases in which online lessons are disrupted by strangers who show pornographic material and confront children with sexual images. While some children are traumatized by such images, others desire more -

often as a relief from boredom, frustration or loneliness. For some, it becomes the entry point into porn-addiction, which experts say can become a life-long affliction. At the same time, the so-called "Schulhof KiPo" (German expression for child pornography in the school yard) has been increasing exponentially since the beginning of the year: children and young people take photographs and film themselves in pornographic poses or actions, and upload the results to the Internet and mobile phones. The consequences of exposure to pornography for children and their character development are extremely serious.

Prayer

- For protection of our children from all sources of undetected and uncontrolled sexualization and perversion. (Matthew 18:6; Proverbs 4:23)
- For parents and teachers to be alert and sensitized to recognise when children are involved in pornography. (1 Peter 5:8)
- For help, healing and deliverance for children and young people affected by or addicted to pornographic material. (Isaiah 61,1) -TF-

Coalition negotiations in Israel

On March 23rd, the Knesset was re-elected for the fourth time in two years. According to current projections, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's conservative Likud party will remain the strongest party in parliament. As after the experiences of previous elections, forming a coalition will be difficult. The parties of the conservative-religious camp when combined did not achieve the required absolute majority of 61 seats. As the strongest challenger, Yair Lapid and his left-wing liberal Yesch Atid party will also find it difficult to establish a coalition of the very diverse parties which are opposed to Netanyahu as Prime Minister. The Arab party Ra'am could tip the scales.

After the election, President Rivlin instructs the candidate, chosen by the members of the Knesset to be the potential Prime Minister, to form a government. He has four weeks to form a coalition, but can then apply for an extension of two weeks. At the same time, the interrogation of witnesses in the corruption trial against Netanyahu begins on April 5th. Before the elections there were protests against him across the country, also because of the repeated lockdowns and the massive damage to the economy. With around one million job seekers, unemployment is close to 25%. In the election campaign, Netanyahu mainly relied on the successful vaccination campaign and encouraged the Arab minority to support him. **Prayer:**

- Let us support Israel in prayer for the formation of a stable government coalition. (Daniel 2:20-22)
- Let us pray for a government that will lead Israel beyond the corona crisis and through the worldwide upheavals according to its purpose. (Isaiah 48:17)
- For the Israeli economy and society, for healing and recovery. (John 14:27) -KH-
