With this summer bulletin we would like to inform you about our finances. We do this with great joy! In the past years we have experienced God's provision as a prayer network again and again. In these weeks when we hear of rising prices, inflation and supply shortages, we sense how God is calling us to trust Him and not give room to a mentality whereby we feel that we do not have enough. Rather that we depend on God all the more, as did Isaac, who sowed in the midst of a famine and reaped a hundredfold harvest. In the midst of crises, God wants to bless us abundantly as the Body of Christ and call us to be a blessing. Heaven has made provision for this time. And so we know: there are no needs that he does not want to meet according to the riches of His glory in Jesus Christ (Phil 4:19). This is true for us and for everyone in the body of Christ and our country!

Developing a Provider Mentality

As the Body of Christ, we are challenged to be wise stewards of spiritual as well as material goods. Old systems of provision and security may be shaken even more, but in the end it will be good for us! God is calling us deeper into union with him and with each other, in growing together and supporting one another. "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms" (1 Peter 4:10). This is the attitude we want to encourage more and more.

Impulse Giver in our Land

In order to support prayer with important impulses in our country, we need, despite our prayers for the Watchman's Call, a financial seed in order to continue the ministry of intercession for politics and society. We are currently financially supported by **less than 5 percent** of our prayer warriors. For such a large ministry as the Watchmen's Call, there are relatively few shoulders on which we rely to support the financial underpinnings, and we wonder why that is. Are many of us perhaps not aware that a prayer network also needs finances for personnel (e.g. for salary, income tax, social insurance)? Financial support is also needed for other obligations that come with running an association, such as tax advisors, association liability, license agreements, software and technical equipment, etc. in order to give prayer impulses to our country.

To put it in a nutshell. Whoever supports us with finances invests ...

- **Ultimately in God** We are first and foremost seeking His heart and fellowship with Him in order to take up prayer requests in such a way that they will reflect his heartbeat.
- In society and in the politics of our land We are called together, as watchmen by God, for intercession for Germany.
- For the spiritual growth of prayer We offer teaching in conferences and seminars/webinars, and we grow together in prayer.
- In the unity of the Body of Christ The Watchman's call does not stand alone, but is linked to many works and ministries around the country.

For our dedicated work we need financial support and we are looking for partners. You have the opportunity to be providers for the Watchman's Call and to share in the blessing and transformational power of prayer. We would be very happy if you open your hearts as individual churches or prayer groups. We urgently need more partners who are able to support us financially, **if possible on a regular basis**.
